Programs for Winter Term

- **AM Open Gym (6:30-7:30AM):** Students will have the chance to warm up their bodies and brains before heading to class by playing basketball and other gym activities. Teacher: Mr. Lockwood
- **Futsal (girls & boys):** Like indoor soccer but much faster and without walls. Players will develop strong touches on the ball and improve their skills.
